

POSTGRADUATE COURSES

Until the beginning of the year 2012, the Romanian universities could establish and carry out postgraduate courses only with the approval of the university senates. On February 1, 2012, has appeared the *Order of the Ministry of Education No. 3163/2012 concerning the organization and functioning of postgraduate programs and professional development training*. Among others, this Order requires that these programmes must be approved by the Ministry of Education in light of new criteria. Accordingly, all universities reconsidered anew these programmes. Consequently, TMU has proposed for approval the following postgraduate courses:
