- 20th September 1990 TMU acquired juridical status, as a private higher education, non-profit institution;
- 23rd April- by Law no.239, published in Romanian Official Gazette, First Part, no. 291, of 30th April 2002, the University became juridical institution, of private law and public utility, part of National System of Education
- Currently, the University includes 10 faculties: Law; Psychology; Finance; Banking; Accounting and Business Administration: Medicine; Dental Medicine: Pharmacy; Informatics; Social, Political and Humanistic Sciences; Law and Economic Sciences, Tg. Jiu; Nursing, Tg. Jiu and carries on 21 bachelor's degree studies (full time&distance learning) and 25 MA studies.
- Within the University, two Doctoral Schools carry out their activities: Law and Dental Medicine.
- The university organizes admittance exams; during the university year 2016–2017 more than 8000 students were enlisted. So far, over 33.000 students have graduated from this university more than 10.000 graduates have continued their studies, attending MA programs and over 100 graduates with a PHD.
- The University also hosts the Institute of Studies, Research, Development and Innovation and "Acad. Nicolae Cajal" Medical Research Institute, which have intense scientific research activities in all its 9 interdisciplinary centers.
- The University carries on financed European projects POSDRU/PODCA
- The didactical and scientific research activities are carried out by highly qualified teachers, prominent figures of scientific public life, members of the Romanian Academy, Academy of Romanian Scientists and Medical Science Academy.

THE UNIVERSITY LOGO

In 25 years, Titu Maiorescu University has built up the status of a Higher Education Institution, which generates advanced knowledge, promoting excellence and performance, through its bachelor's, master and doctoral studies. Its institutional identity is symbolically concentrated in the University logo, which expresses graphically and chromatically the assumed values and mission, dynamism and professionalism. Structurally, it is a combined logo, made up of the Logotype and the Symbol Graphic. The key element is represented by a stylized pen, as a symbol of education, study, research, creativity and innovation. It is framed by a circle, symbolizing perfection and featuring the symbolic space of knowledge, the aspiration towards perfection.

The chromatics of the logo is bicolor – golden and dark blue. The dark blue expresses loyalty, harmony, enthusiasm to everything that is elated, serious, true, tolerant and free.

The golden – the color of sun and light, symbolizes love for knowledge, energy, vitality, perseverance and determination.




The calling for good and truth will not disappear as long as there are legal university communities, as long as competent and honest people have the will to work properly, to contribute to the social good.


Dear students, the faculty management and staff provide the students with the most updated theoretical and practical knowledge, modern methods of teaching within the field of informatics.


