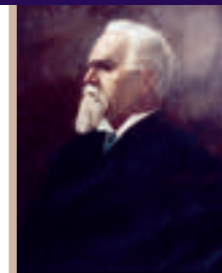

Titu Maiorescu University in a nutshell:

- September 20, 1990 – Titu Maiorescu University was founded as a non-profit, private Higher Education Institution.
- April 23, 2002 – According to Law 239, Part I no. 291 from April 30, 2002, The University became a legal person of private law and public utility, part of the National Education System.
- Titu Maiorescu University offers great learning opportunities in:
