- **4.1. Title** of the chapters (Times New Roman, size 10, Bold, Capitals, Left alignment). Free space (1 line).
- **4.2.** Subtitles of the chapters (Times New Roman, size 10, Bold, Lowercase, Left alignment). Free space (1 line)
- **4.3.** The text should be arranged by one, size 10, line spacing: 1 line, tab 0,5 cm.
- **4.4.** Equations, formulas, symbols and measure units

The equations and formulas are written beginning from the left part of the column, consequently numbered, the reference being made at the corresponding number.

Free space (1 line) should be left before and after each equation.

Use the ISN notation and the Arabian numbering.

Name, initial / title of the paper, publishing house, year.

The references should be written in alphabetical order, being numbered.
