Development of Modern Psychodynamic Psychotherapies and Results of Comparative Psychotherapy Research

Based on classical psychoanalysis, psychodynamic therapies have developed significantly in recent decades. They have become more symptomoriented, more focused and considerably shorter. However, this has also made it possible to transfer them into therapy manuals, which are the basis for empirical comparative psychotherapy studies. In this presentation, some of these psychodynamically oriented short therapies will be introduced. In addition, current results of comparative therapy research will be reported. The main findings here are that it is much less the applied therapy method that matters, but much more the psychotherapeutic relationship and the fitting of patient and therapist to each other.
