

- ▶ Erasmus+ is the EU program for education, training, youth and sport.
 - ▶ It is addressed to all the students enrolled in a European University, regardless of their citizenship.
 - ▶ It offers to participants the possibility to study, train and gain experience abroad.

Inclusion and diversity

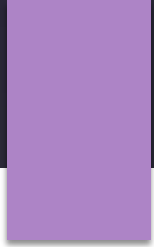
- ▶ the programme is open to people of different ages and from diverse cultural, social and economic backgrounds;
- ▶ It focuses on people with fewer opportunities, including those with disabilities, educational difficulties, or a migrant background.





Green Erasmus+

- ▶ Participants are encouraged to use lower carbon transport as an alternative to flying;
- ▶ Take a train or a bus to reach your Erasmus mobility destination, as low-carbon alternatives to short-haul flights.

Mobility for studies (SMS)

- academic year 2025/2026 -

- ▶ For **long study mobility (SMS)** the host university will be chosen from **the list of partner universities**;
- ▶ **Short mobilities** can be found here **<https://erasmusbp.org/list-of-bips/>**;
- ▶ The file includes:
 - registration form (webiste)
 - ID card/passport – copy
 - registration certificate in Romania (EU students) / permit of residence in Romania (non-EU students);
 - letter of intent
 - letter of recommendation
 - transcript of records (issued by the secretary)
 - language certificate (if you don't have it, a language examination will be organized by TMU)

Erasmus+ Grant

- Erasmus+ grant represents co-financing from the European Commission, which partly covers the living expenses during mobility;
- At the host university, the student is exempt from tuition or enrollment fees and has access to the library, the laboratories and other facilities of the university.

- ▶ 80% of the grant is offered before mobility and 20% of the grant if offered after the mobility.

Additional financial support

- ▶ TMU offers additional financial support for study mobilities by exempting the tuition fee during the mobility for several students representing approximately 1% of the number of students eligible to participate in mobilities, at the level of each study program.

- summer 2025 -

- ▶ The file includes:
 - registration form (webiste)
 - ID card/passport – copy
 - registration certificate in Romania (EU students) / permit of residence in Romania (non-EU students);
 - letter of intent
 - letter of recommendation
 - transcript of records (issued by the secretary)
 - acceptance letter/email (if applicable)

Where to go...

- ✓ For **traineeship mobilities (SMT)**, the students present the acceptance letter/email from the host organisation:
 - Organisation that offer traineeship opportunities through the Erasmus+ program can be found on the website **www.erasmusintern.org**;
 - Contact AIESEC Bucharest for support in finding a host organization (a fee of 180 EUR is charged for those who go on mobility through AIESEC);

Important!

students who want to go on mobility in organizations run by one of their parents are not eligible for an Erasmus mobility

international students who want to go on mobility in their home country will be on the waiting list. Priority is given to students who have not been on mobility before and those who apply for a mobility in other country than the one of origin

Short mobility

- ▶ Virtual component
- ▶ 80% of the grant is offered before mobility and 20% of the grant if offered after the mobility (15-30 days).

Faculty

- ✓ Students are selected by the faculty
- ✓ The Learning Agreement (LA) can be signed only by the Erasmus coordinator from the faculty

International Relations Department (DRI)

- ✓ DRI takes care of the administrative and financial sides of your mobility
- ✓ Missing deadlines from DRI can lead to the suspension/cancellation of the mobility!

Host Organisation/University

- ✓ The student is the link between TMU and the host organization/university
- ✓ Missing deadlines from the host organization/university can lead to the cancellation of the mobility
- ✓ The host organisation/university must approve the Learning Agreement too

Learning Agreement

- All students will complete the **Learning Agreement** (LA) which will include the study/ traineeship program they will follow during the mobility;
- The document will be signed by the student, the Erasmus+ coordinator within TMU and the Erasmus+ coordinator from the partner university/ host organisation;
- Any changed to LA has to be aproved by all 3 parties, otherwise is not valid.



Other documents

- ▶ The host organization/university can ask for different documents (application form, transcript of records, insurance, criminal record, vaccination form, ID/passport, etc.)
- ▶ EURO account statement
 - The commission (1-2 EUR) between transactions is covered by the student (high commission for accounts open in non-EU countries – 20/40 EUR)
 - Revolut is accepted (the Lithuanian IBAN)
- ▶ Insurance
 - European Health Card (if the host country is from EU)
 - health insurance (if the host country is outside EU)
- ▶ financial guarantee declaration

Insurance

- ▶ For study mobility:
 - At least health insurance valid in the host country and/or the European Health Insurance Card.
- ▶ For traineeship mobility:
 - Health insurance valid in the host country and/or the European Health Insurance Card;
 - Accident insurance;
 - Liability insurance.
