## ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

Titu Maiorescu University offers accommodation in two dormitories (C3 and C5) located at [Blvd. Gheorghe Șincai, No. 16, Sector 4, Bucharest](#) with the following options:

### Other details:

1. In addition to the number of beds detailed above, the studios are equipped with wardrobes, two cupboards, a desk, a refrigerator, an LCD TV, CATV, internet, a kitchen, and a bathroom.
2. Each apartment has two bathrooms and one desk in each room, with two or three chairs depending on the number of students (two or three) in the room. There is also a study room in each dormitory, with many desks that students can use for studying.
3. Rooms are not equipped with pillows, bed sheets, towels, or blankets; therefore, students need to bring their own.
4. The C3 dormitory features an eco-wash facility, which is just two minutes away from the C5 dormitory. The premises are monitored with 24-hour security and CCTV, and there are additional amenities such as a study room, gym, free parking in the courtyard, and paid parking with video surveillance.

5. The kitchens in the C5 dormitory are not equipped with a microwave oven or electric hob, but students are allowed to bring their own electric hob or cooking device.
6. **Given this situation, the Dormitory Administrative Office recommends that international and Erasmus students choose accommodation in C3 to benefit from a fully equipped kitchen.**
7. The dormitories are within walking distance of Titu Maiorescu University's headquarters (**Timpuri Noi campus**) – Building M and Building V ([Calea Vacaresti 189](#) and [Calea Vacaresti 187](#)). The public transport network (subway and bus) is very close, making the dormitories a comfortable and safe place to call home while studying at Titu Maiorescu University.
8. The Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Dental Medicine are located [here](#), just four subway stations from the "Timpuri Noi" station, plus approximately a 10-minute walk.

10. The accommodation contract is signed for a minimum of five months (one semester) with the possibility of extension. **Erasmus students participating in a mobility period shorter than 5 months shall be eligible for dormitory accommodation.**
11. Payment for the dormitories is made monthly, within the first 10 days of each month.
12. The university charges a deposit equal to one month's fee. This deposit should be paid at the same time as the first month's fee on the day of check-in. The first month's fee and the deposit are to be paid at the university's cash desk, where only RON (Romanian leu) is accepted in cash. For subsequent months, rent can also be paid by bank transfer.
13. The deposit will remain in the university's account until the end of the accommodation contract. If the student wishes to terminate the contract within the first five months from the start of the agreement, the deposit will not be refunded. If the student wishes to terminate the contract after five months, the deposit will be refunded.
14. **Please keep in mind that check-in at the dormitory can only be done between 8 AM and 4 PM, from Monday to Friday. If you arrive in Bucharest over the weekend or after 4 PM, consider booking a room in a hotel or hostel for your first night(s).**

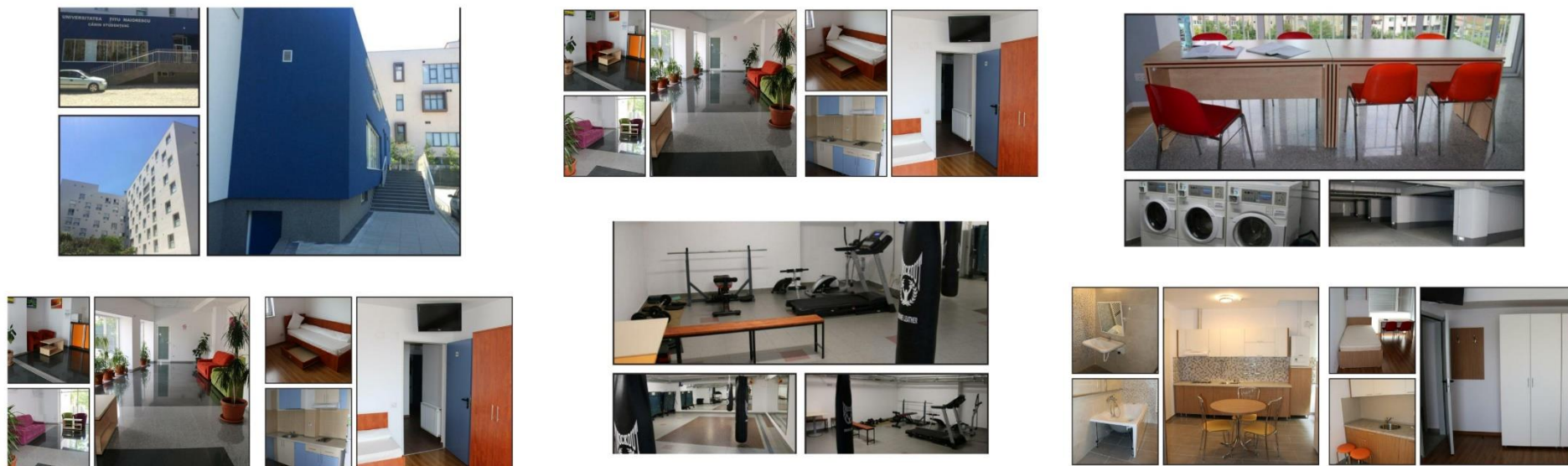
