General information about this evaluation notebook

- This notebook is intended **only** for the students of the **Faculty of Medicine, Medicine in English Programme, Titu Maiorescu University of Bucharest**.
 - The notebook consists of **two sections**: Medical Specialities and Surgical Specialities, with a total of **120 h of duty shift in the hospital (40 h for Medical Specialities and 80 h for Surgical Specialities)**, with a maximum of **8 h per day**;
 - Entries can be completed in whatever order, not necessarily in a chronological one, however all entries must be completed, evaluated and signed (both by the student and the evaluating physician)
 - Not all duty hours must be performed in the same hospital, therefore each entry contains the name of the hospital and of the ward/department.
 - All entries **must be hand written; computer input is not allowed**;
 - After printing and completing this workbook must be binded with a simple and clear cover before being handed to the secretary.

- General Surgery – Preoperative preparation in emergency surgery
- General Surgery – Drainage techniques, wound care, infection assessment
- Pediatric Surgery – Surgical pathology in children
- Pediatric Orthopedics – Emergency cases (fractures, dislocations)
- Orthopedics & Traumatology – Upper limb trauma
- Orthopedics & Traumatology – Lower limb trauma
- Orthopedics & Traumatology – Polytrauma evaluation
